Isaiah 26: 3 & 4

You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you. Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD, the LORD himself, is the Rock eternal.

I have heard a lot about foundations in the last few weeks. It seems to be coming up in conversations all the time.

"Got to water the foundation of the house because I don't want it to crack. Got to make sure the foundation of our organization is strong to weather the storm so we can grow again later. Got to work on stabilizing my foundation so I don't lose my balance."

Foundations are important in all areas of our lives because that is the place from which we grow. If the foundation isn't solid then we are setting ourselves up for failure. Isaiah said that the foundation of our minds must be steadfast to have peace. So, what does it mean to be steadfast and how do we achieve it?

Steadfast is really all about having a firm, solid base under our feet. And the achievement of that foundation is Christ. Isaiah knew that peace comes in the chaos when you can rely on the foundation that you stand on. You have to have feet on solid ground. I long for peace in a crazy, mixed-up world and I know that the people around me can't give it to me. God and God alone provides me that foundation that I can trust in.

He is my Rock. And no matter the chaotic storm that life throws at me, I can grab hold of that Rock and it will be my stability. That's what it means to be steadfast. No matter what, I can know with all assurance that I have sure footing and I can trust in it. There I will find my peace in the midst of the storm. All I have to do is Trust. The rest is all about God.
