In 1529, Martin Luther wrote and published the Small Catechism to instruct pastors and preachers that there was great need for the doctrine to be taught among the villages and city parishes. In his preface, he wrote how miserable it made him feel to know that the people claimed their faith in Christ, but had no knowledge of what they believed.

Martin Luther said, "The common people, especially in the villages, have no knowledge whatever of Christian doctrine, and, alas! many pastors are altogether incapable and incompetent to teach [so much so, that one is ashamed to speak of it]. Nevertheless, all maintain that they are Christians, have been baptized and receive the [common] holy Sacraments. Yet, they [do not understand and] cannot [even] recite either the Lord's Prayer, or the Creed, or the Ten Commandments."

After reading the preface, I am glad that I didn't live in his area in 1529. I probably would have had to consider a different profession.

But I know that today, even though we are far more educated in the modern era, we can still find ourselves at a loss about what we believe and how we apply that faith that we have in Christ. That's why we do Confirmation in part...to know what we believe. But, it is an ongoing process.

Beginning March 5, we will be doing a study on our Christian (specifically Lutheran) beliefs according to the Small Catechism. The exact details of how we are going to study it are not solidified as of yet, but it will be in Felger Hall from 6:30p - 8:00p starting on Tuesday, March 5. The idea behind the study is not about judgment or proving how smart or faithful we are by displaying our knowledge. The intent is to clarify and solidify what we believe so that we can more effectively follow Christ.


It will be as much about *my* study and learning as it will be anyone's, so come and journey together with me as we look at our faith through Scripture and the Small Catechism.



ADULT EVENING CONFIRMATION STUDY

The Latin word *confirmare*, the earliest ancestor of "confirmation," literally means "to strengthen." Paired with the word "faith," this produces an appropriate definition of "confirmation" as used in this way—it's a time to *strengthen faith*.

Beginning March 5, Pastor Chip will be leading a study on our Christian (specifically Lutheran) beliefs according to the Small Catechism. We will meet in Felger Hall on **Tuesdays** from 6:30p – 8:00p.

Come learn, renew, or refresh your knowledge of Lutheranism. The basis for this study is not about judgment or proving how smart or faithful we are by displaying our knowledge. The intent is to clarify and solidify what we believe so that we can more effectively follow Christ. Come and journey together with Pastor Chip as we look at our faith through Scripture and the Small Catechism.

<u>COCOON TREE</u> – Beginning Ash Wednesday, you may notice a new addition to the sanctuary of our church! What you will see is the Cocoon Tree that has been constructed for use during the Lenten season by the Board of Worship.

When worms spin their cocoons, they enter a period of hibernation and then transformation. They emerge at the end of this time as beautiful butterflies, transformed into new bodies, with a new life and purpose.

So it is with man. We are like the worms when we are without Christ, living from day to day, hoping not to be eaten by a hungry bird or another insect! When we hear and accept the Good News of Christ's resurrection, we also become transformed. We are like the butterflies with a new spirit, with new purpose for life— to live for Christ and to do his will.

The Lenten season, one of reflection and meditation, corresponds to the hibernation of those worms, waiting in their cocoons,

anticipating their new lives. It is like the reflection we do of our lives that we engage in during the Lenten season.

On Easter Sunday, the cocoons will be replaced with butterflies, dogwood blossoms, crystals, and shells. The butterflies represent new life in Christ. The shells and crystals represent water and baptism, which are also symbols for rebirth and regeneration, a new life as a Christian.
