I have enjoyed watching the process of putting in the new parking lot at the church. There are several things that have intrigued me as it has gone through the transformation. And, not only have I learned some things about construction and concrete: I have learned some things about faithfulness as well.

The most important thing that I learned, though, was simply about the entire process. I watched a small group of people, commissioned to do the work of getting the parking lot done, work tirelessly to get it completed before Christmas Eve. And so, it has happened. But their dedication was not always easy. There were some bumps in the road (planning, variances, weather, and other things) that could have derailed it. But the transformation happened.

I look at people in this world much like that parking lot.

When we look at them, we see some scars and some brokenness on the outside. They have been hurt and abused in different ways, but we can't see everything. When we start to get under the surface, the real scars become evident. They are deep and hidden under layers and layers of stuff. Sometimes there are even some unexpected things hiding far below the surface.

Then those scars are healed...slowly and with much work...and through the love of God and his people, transformation comes about, foundations are laid, and the forms are put in place to build a new life in Christ. Then God transforms. We are changed in His love. We are made new.

As I walked across the concrete days after it was poured, I thought to myself about all the work that went into the creation under my feet. It really was a true labor and so is making but more importantly being disciples. We are in process. Some digging up the old, some healing old wounds, some putting structure in place, some getting fresh foundation, and some solidly doing the work that we were created for. We are all in process. Don't forget that. You are not done yet.

Philippians 1:4-6 In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.


Heritage Day Celebration Steering Committee
